Credit Union Service Network Expanding in Colorado, Iowa, New Mexico, and Wyoming

LAKESWOOD, CO (May 2, 2008)—Credit Union Service Network (CUSN) proudly announces several new credit unions and locations to shared branching.

In Colorado, Bellco Credit Union joined shared branching, offering its membership the convenience of over 3,200 locations nationwide; additionally they opened all fourteen of their branches as CU Service Centers, to add convenient locations for guest member use. The fourteen new service centers are located in Aurora, Centennial, Denver, Englewood, Glendale, Lakewood, Littleton, Northglenn, Parker, Westminster, and Wheat Ridge. Credit union members that are part of the shared branching network may immediately begin using these new locations.

Denver Water Credit Union has also joined shared branching and opened their one location as a CU Service Center. Credit union members that are part of the shared branching network can begin to use this new location.

Members Federal Credit Union in Aurora, Colorado has participated in shared branching for several years and continues to see the benefits for their members. Members CU opened a new branch in April and immediately added shared branching providing guest members with even more choices of where they can conduct their business.

In Iowa, Community Choice Credit Union in Johnston, Iowa, and Advantage Credit Union in Newton, Iowa have joined shared branching as issuers—their membership can use any CU Service Center nationwide.

In New Mexico, Guadalupe Credit Union in Santa Fe has been active with shared branching for several years. Guadalupe CU opened a new branch in April and moved a previous service center location as well.

In Wyoming, Warren Federal Credit Union in Cheyenne has been involved in shared branching, since 2002, and recently opened a new location on Yellowstone Road.
