SHARED BRANCHING EXCELLENCE IN CREDIT UNIONS**

The awards were presented during the CUSN 2010 Annual Meeting at the Marriott West, Golden, Colorado on May 14, 2010. CUSN presented awards to the following recipients:

Excellence Award—*The first two awards were presented to credit unions that have been active on the network for at least 3 years and have achieved the greatest growth in 2009.*

Greatest Issuer Transaction Growth

Neighborhood Community Federal Credit Union—Grew 103%

Greatest Acquirer Transaction Growth

Aurora Schools Federal Credit Union—Grew 132%

Largest Ratio of Annual Issuer Transactions to Total Members

Arapahoe Credit Union—Ratio of 7.0

CUSN also presented a **Vision Award**. The award was presented to Mr. C. Michael Litzau, Sooper Credit Union, who has helped create the vision for CUSN. Mr. Litzau served as Director/Manager on the CU Service Network Board from 1992–2010, as a pioneer to the concept of shared branching; and helped build the national shared branching network with unwavering adherence to basic credit union philosophy; and his identity with the principles on which credit unions are grounded contributed stability in growth to the credit union shared branching. He has demonstrated the true cooperative spirit of people helping people by serving credit unions as Chairman of the Colorado CU League, Chairman of the Colorado CU Foundation, Chairman of NASCUS, Chairman of RAMACHA/PRO and on several other boards and committees, such as: Governmental Affairs, NACHA, CUNA, Western CUNA Management School Board.
